Week 1 – June 18-22, 2018

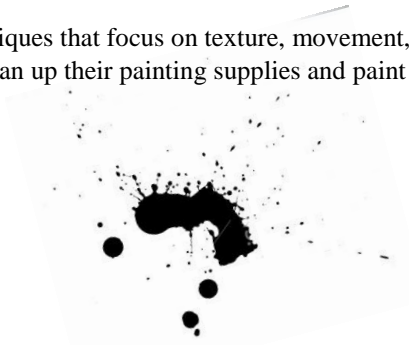
